### **Guest Speaker for October Meeting - Danny Clancy**

A native of Dallas, Texas, Daniel Clancy began his career in the Dallas County District Attorney's Office in 1992. During a 5 year term with the District Attorney's office, Mr. Clancy tried hundreds of criminal cases ranging from DWI to Capital Murder. He quickly established a reputation for being an excellent trial attorney with an advanced understanding of the rules of evidence and courtroom procedure.

In 1999, Daniel Clancy was elected Judge of County Criminal Court #1 of Dallas County. In 2005, Judge Clancy was appointed by the Texas Governor to preside over one of Dallas County's newest felony benches; Criminal District Court #6. For over 7 years, Judge Clancy presided over thousands of criminal cases. In 2001 and 2002, Judge Daniel Clancy was elected by the Dallas County Criminal Court Judges to serve as their Presiding Judge.

Twice named one of Dallas' best lawyers by D Magazine, Clancy has been in private practice since 2007. A proud graduate of Jesuit High School, Clancy earned a B.A. degree in political science with a minor in criminal justice and a law degree from Mississippi College School of Law in Jackson, Mississippi. He resides in Dallas with his wife Julie and their three children. He is a member of the St. Monica Catholic Church and an active volunteer, serving as a Board of Management member at the Town North YMCA.
